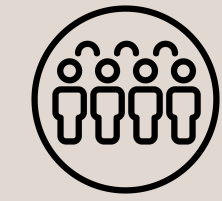


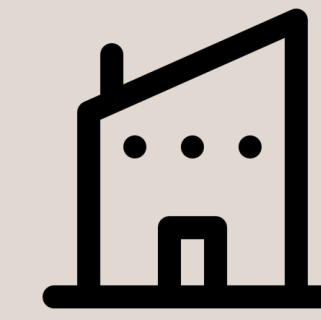
Employment within the sector (2024)

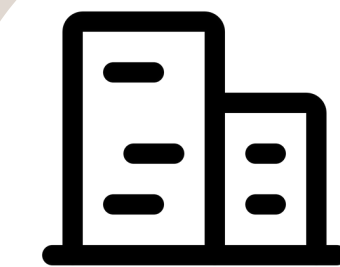

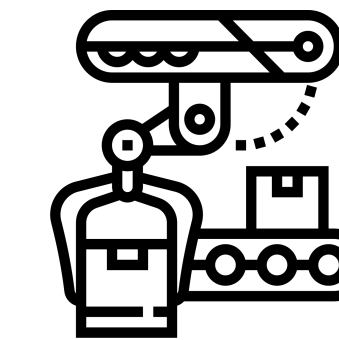

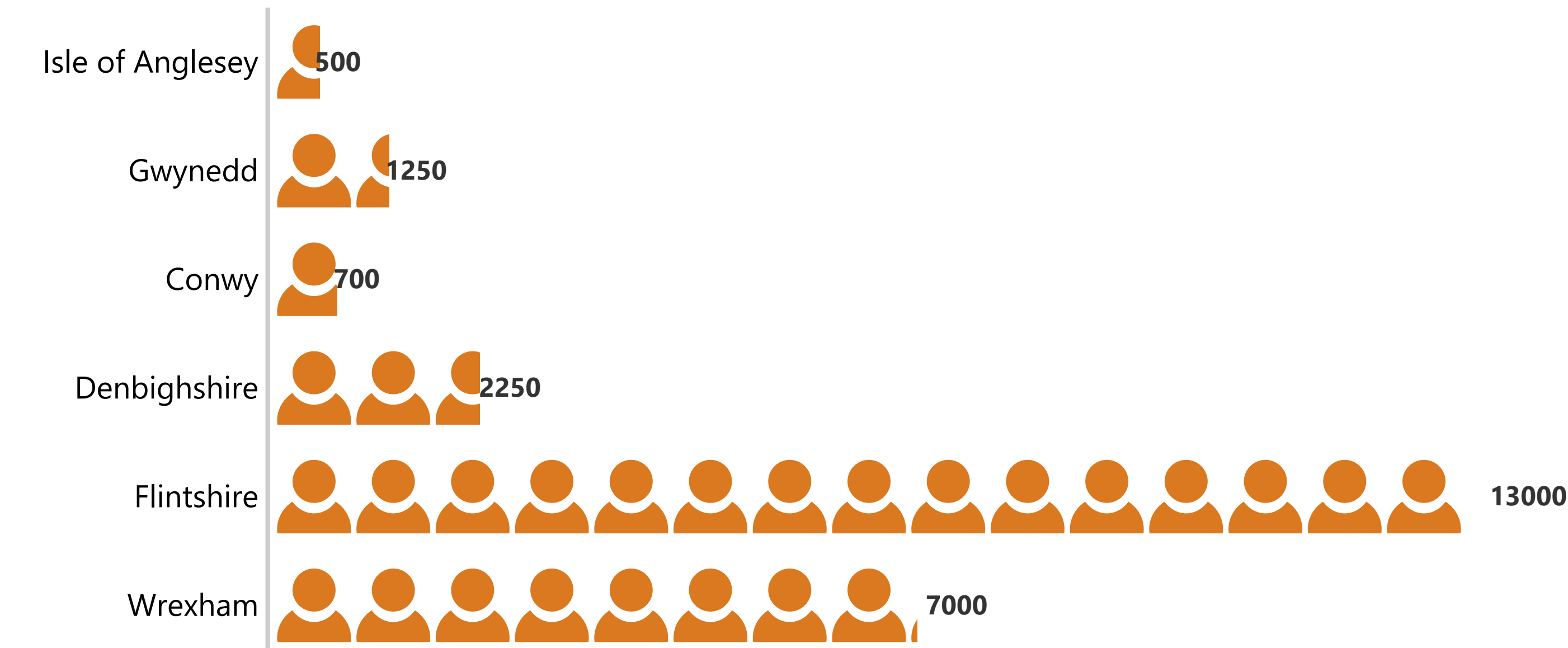

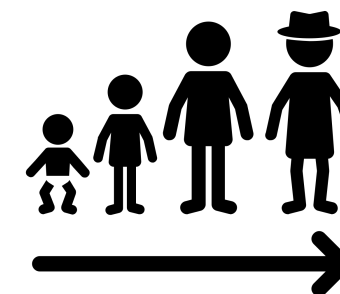

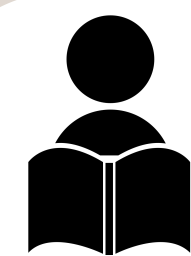
