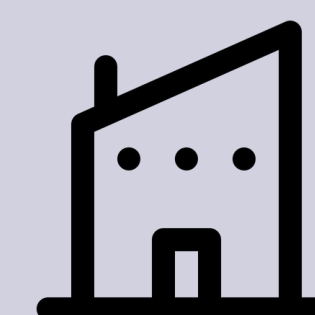

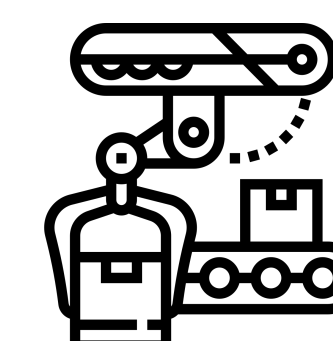

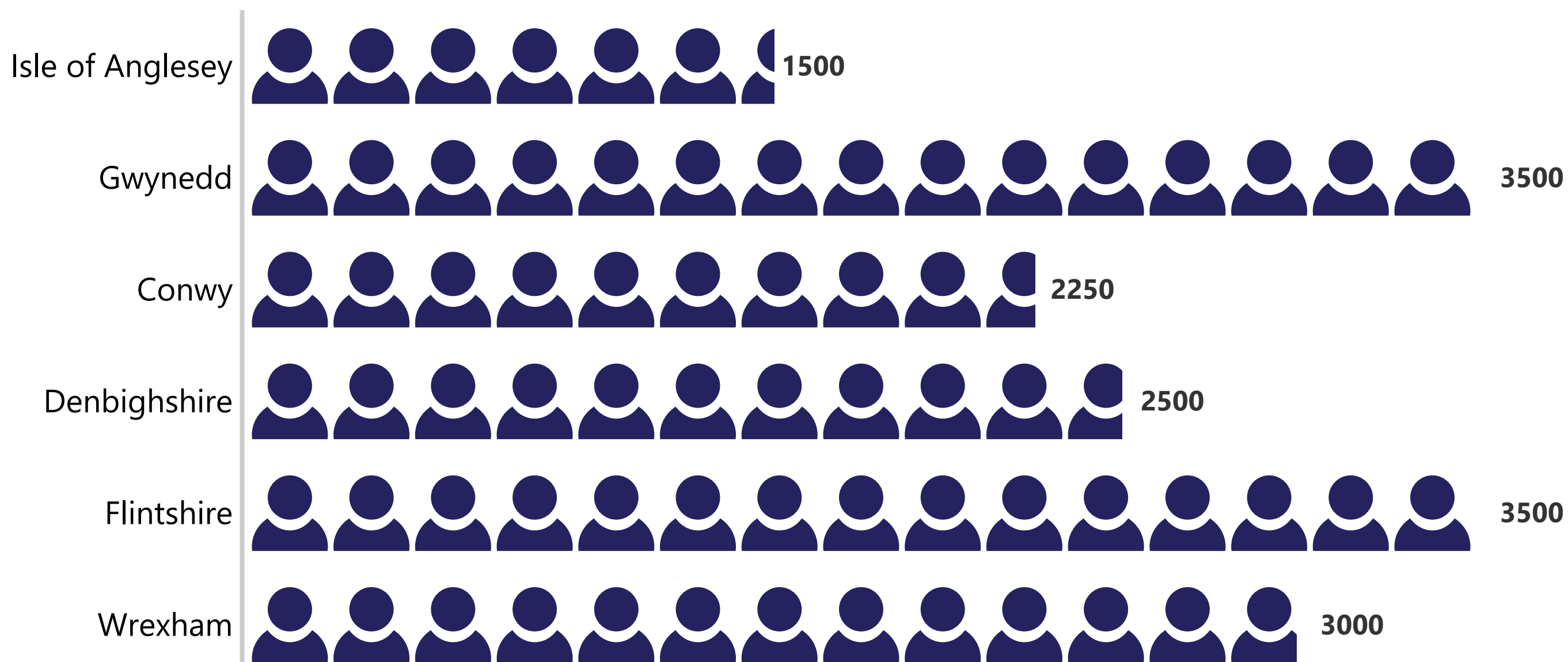

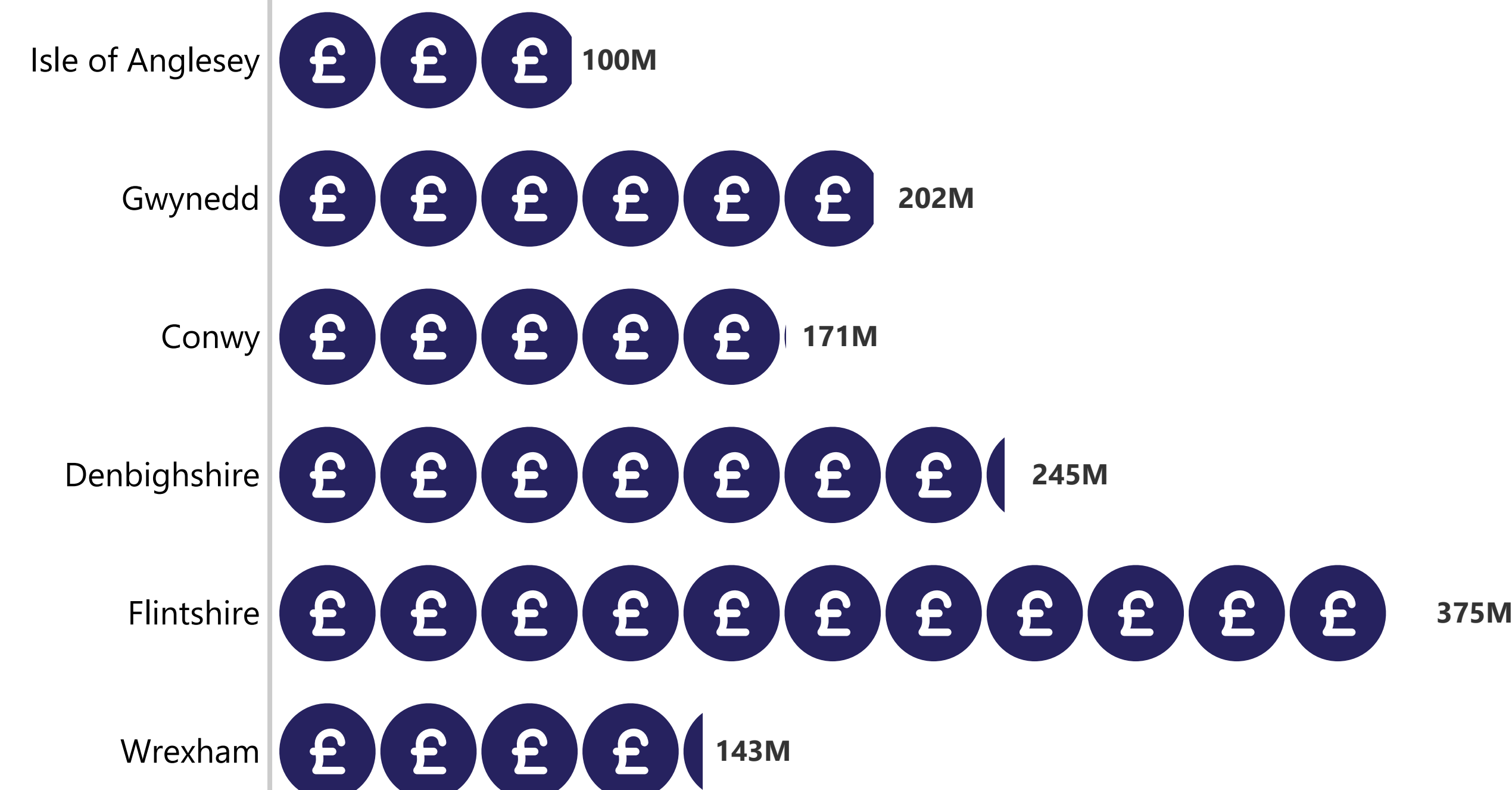

Gross Value Added (GVA) (£) for the sector (2023)



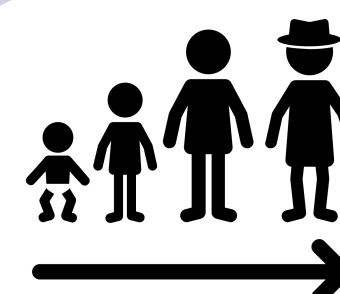

Training within the sector (2024/25)



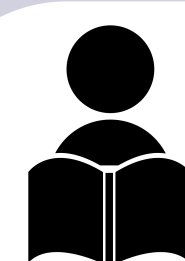
